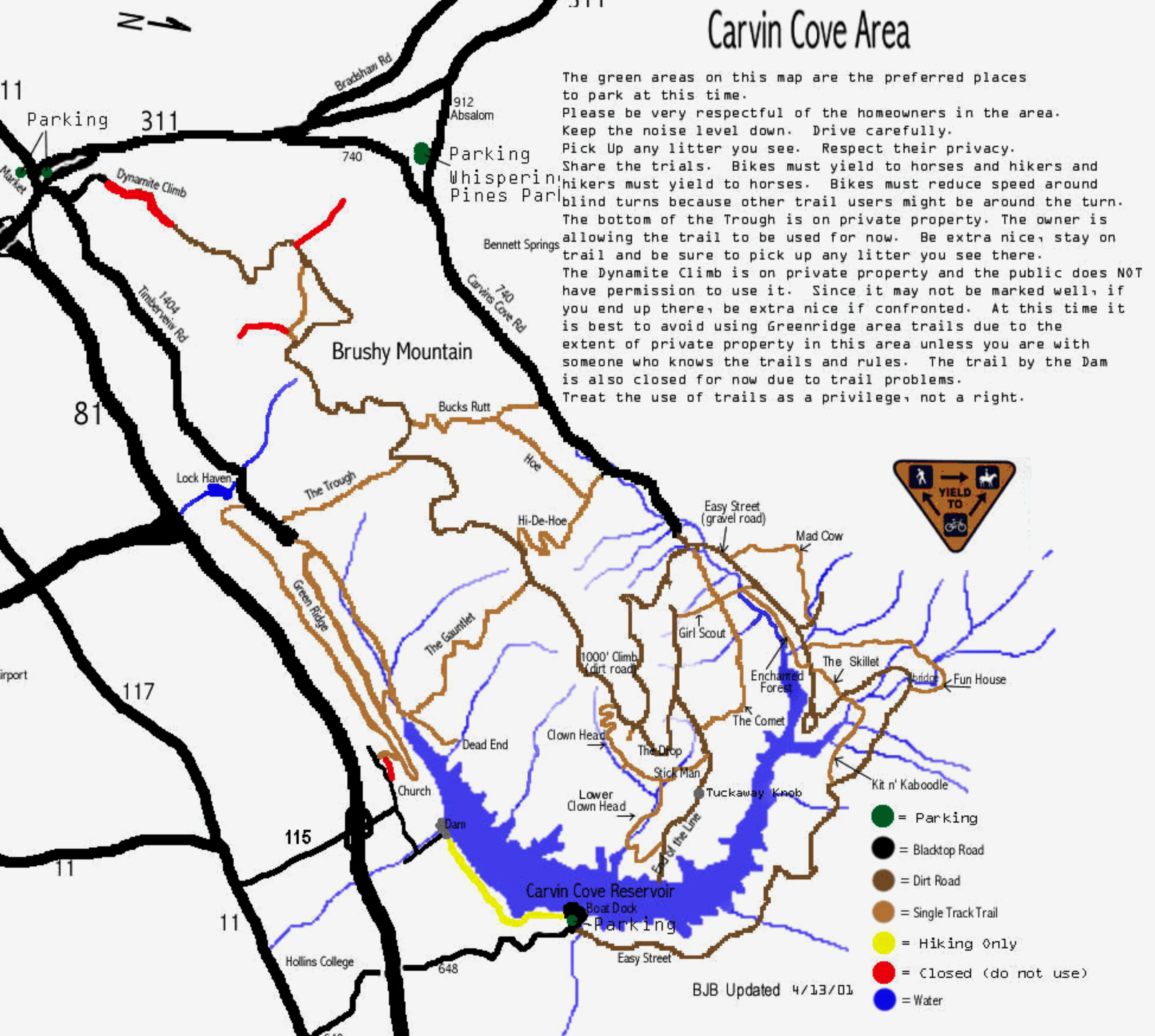


Carvin Cove Area

The green areas on this map are the preferred places to park at this time. Please be very respectful of the homeowners in the area. Keep the noise level down. Drive carefully. Pick Up any litter you see. Respect their privacy. Share the trails. Bikes must yield to horses and hikers and hikers must yield to horses. Bikes must reduce speed around blind turns because other trail users might be around the turn. The bottom of the Trough is on private property. The owner is allowing the trail to be used for now. Be extra nice, stay on trail and be sure to pick up any litter you see there. The Dynamite Climb is on private property and the public does NOT have permission to use it. Since it may not be marked well, if you end up there, be extra nice if confronted. At this time it is best to avoid using Greenridge area trails due to the extent of private property in this area unless you are with someone who knows the trails and rules. The trail by the Dam is also closed for now due to trail problems. Treat the use of trails as a privilege, not a right.
